**STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT
PERAK GOLD VASE MEETING 2016 – 1st DAY, SATURDAY, 16th JULY 2016**

STATE OF TRACK: Good

RACE 1 (R892) CLASS 5 – 1600m(lc) – LOONSHIANG 1969 HANDICAP

Steady rain fell prior to and during the running of the race.

PISCES GEM (R Woodworth) was slow to begin.

ALACARTE (J Low) had to be steadied racing to the 1000M, when FLYING GIFT (App AK Lim) rolled in.

All riders returned an average of 1kg over.

Post-race veterinary examinations of GOOD GIFT (App M Hanif), GREAT PRINCE (App KC Wong) and BOWEN LAD (J Shankar) revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 2 (R893) CLASS 5 – 1600m(lc) – KING'S KNIGHT 1967 HANDICAP

WENONA'S LEGACY (C Goon) stumbled at the 1300M, unbalancing its rider for a short distance.

KING OF THE CREEK (J Low) raced wide from the 800M until entering the straight.

GRAND SHOW (App M Hanif) had to be eased to avoid the heels of RUNFORIT (S Sandana) passing the 600M.

PERFECTLY PERFECT (Lou Ho) which raced poorly, will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

Jockeys HK Cheng, App J Daniel, Lou Ho and S Sandana, the respective rider of EMPEROR QIAN LONG, HUMMING BIRD, PERFECTLY PERFECT and RUNFORIT all reported that their mounts were not striding out freely. Post-race veterinary examinations of EMPEROR QIAN LONG, PERFECTLY PERFECT and RUNFORIT revealed no obvious abnormality except HUMMING BIRD which returned lame off fore. As such, HUMMING BIRD will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

RACE 3 (R894) CLASS 4 – 1600m(lc) – NASHOR 1964 HANDICAP

ACOUSTIC (CK Tan) which was difficult to be loaded, will be required to pass one starting stall test before being declared to race again.

IWA ANTILIA (KT Cheng) shifted in on jumping away and bumped POLO MASTER (App AK Lim) which had to be checked and lost its position.

HERE COMES THUNDER (App AM Aizat) had to be steadied racing to the 1200M when SWEET LODGE shifted in. App KC Wong, the rider of SWEET LODGE in the presence of Assistant Trainer Mr. Morli, was shown the video of the incident and warned to exercise more care.

Post-race veterinary examinations of POLO MASTER, THE THINKER (App M Hanif) and HERE COMES THUNDER revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 4 (R895) CLASS 5 – 1400m (lc) – SPRUCE 1966 HANDICAP

JETSTAR EAGLE (App AK Lim) was slow to begin.

UNITY STAR (App BB Singh) shifted out abruptly shortly after the start and checked CERIUM (App KC Tham).

GOOD TASTE (KT Cheng) and CASPER (App AM Aizat) raced keen and were difficult to settle in the early stages of the race.

GOOD TASTE which was racing ungenerously, shifted in sharply, in anticipation of the short course turn, resulting in JP REGIS (J Shankar) which was following, being severely checked and becoming unbalanced for a few strides, losing its position.

CASPER laid in under pressure over the concluding stages of the race.

Jockey J Shankar, the rider of JP REGIS reported that his mount was not striding out freely. Post-race veterinary examinations of JP REGIS and QI POWER (J Low) revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 5 (R896) CLASS 5 –1400m (lc) – FRASER’S HILL 1965 HANDICAP

EL COMANDANTE, a course scratching as it had respiratory allergy, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

LIGHTNING ROD (C Goon) had to be steadied shortly after the start when BUKIT BINTANG (TM Wan) shifted in slightly.

The Stewards questioned Jockey TM Wan, the rider of BUKIT BINTANG and Trainer Nor Azman, the trainer of BUKIT BINTANG as to that gelding’s poor performance today. Jockey TM Wan explained that after a good jump, he tried to settle the gelding, but from shortly after start, BUKIT BINTANG failed to respond to his riding and lost ground. He further stated that he continued to try to improve, using his whip on the gelding in the straight, but at no stage did he respond to his riding. Trainer Nor Azman explained that he was disappointed with BUKIT BINTANG in this race but could offer no explanation as to its apparent poor performance today. BUKIT BINTANG will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again. A post-race veterinary examination of BUKIT BINTANG revealed no obvious abnormality. BUKIT BINTANG was impounded

Post-race veterinary examinations of LIGHTNING ROD and CLAIM (Y Aify) revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 6 (R897) COSMO D (SW) – 1400m (sc) – ACHILLES II 1972 STAKES

VALENTINE BABY which was up 15kgs in body weight since its last run, was checked by the Club Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and was passed fit to start.

AWAKENED (App M Hanif) was slow to begin.

Post-race veterinary examinations of IMMORTALITY (J Shankar) and MARIO ATTLA revealed no obvious abnormality. IMMORTALITY was impounded.

MARIO ATTLA (HK Cheng) which raced poorly, will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

The Stewards questioned Trainer R Lines, the trainer of GOLDHILL PRINCESS as to that mare's improved performance today. Trainer R Lines stated that the mare suffered interference at the previous start and prior to that, had been racing consistently. In his opinion, the good barrier draw and the rain improved its chances in today's race. He further stated that GOLDHILL PRINCESS has been working well and the Stewards noted his explanations.

GENERAL REPORT

SLTC – FRIDAY, 15 JULY 2016

RACE 10 (R852) CLASS 5 – 1700M (LONG COURSE A), SATURDAY, 2 JULY 2016, SELANGOR TURF CLUB JULY MEETING 2016

At the conclusion of an inquiry on 15 July 2016 at the Selangor Turf Club, Jockey SS Vanan, the rider of NO NONSENSE, pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under MRA Rule 44(9)(a)(ii) in that approaching the 200M, he shifted out when insufficiently clear of BULLDOG’S PRIDE (App AM Aizat) and DUEL OF HONOUR (App KC Wong) which were crowded for room as COCONUT (Y Aify) was racing to the outside of these runners. BULLDOG’S PRIDE and DUEL OF HONOUR had to be checked by their riders.

In assessing the penalty, the Stewards took into consideration Jockey SS Vanan’s guilty plea, mitigating factors, previous riding record and his submissions on penalty. Acting on the provisions of MRA Rule 48(5), the Stewards deferred the commencement of Jockey SS Vanan’s suspension. He was suspended from riding in races for a period of four (4) Malaysian race days with effect from 25 July 2016 and to expire on 7 August 2016, both dates inclusive. He was advised of his Right of Appeal (11am).

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INQUIRY INTO A REPORT CONCERNING URINE SAMPLE CODED “J-3368” WHICH WAS TAKEN ON 5 JUNE 2016 AT THE SELANGOR TURF CLUB JUNE MEETING 2016 AND RETURNED POSITIVE TO “DEXTROMETHORPHAN AND ITS METABOLITE (DEXTRORPHAN)”, WHICH IS A PROHIBITED SUBSTANCE IN TERMS OF MRA RULES

The Stewards concluded an inquiry into the above matter on 15 July 2016 at the Selangor Turf Club and statements were taken from App A Farezul, in the presence of his Master, Trainer BT Lim.

App A Farezul pleaded guilty to a charge under MRA Rule 136(3)(b) and the particulars of the charge were that a urine sample coded “J-3368” submitted by him on 5 June 2016 at the Selangor Turf Club June Meeting 2016, on analysis, revealed the presence of “Dextromethorphan and its metabolite (Dextrorphan)”, which is a prohibited substance under the MRA Rules.

In assessing the penalty, the Stewards took into account the nature of the drug, his record, guilty plea, mitigating factors and his submissions on penalty. The Stewards also took into consideration the fact that he was negligent in his practice of self-medicating and failed to declare his medication in his urine collection form and notify the Stewards. He was reminded of his obligations in terms of MRA Rule 136(5)(a)(b)&(c).

App A Farezul was suspended for a period of nine (9) months backdated with effect from 23 June 2016 and to expire on 22 March 2017, both dates inclusive. He was advised of his Right of Appeal (11:25am).

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**INQUIRY INTO A REPORT RELATING TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES
SURROUNDING THE RIDING OF “NO NONSENSE” WHICH WAS RIDDEN BY
APP P DENESKUMAR IN RACE 8 (R659) ON SATURDAY, 21 MAY 2016 AT
THE SELANGOR TURF CLUB MAY MEETING 2016**

The Stewards continued an inquiry into the above matter and took further evidence from App P Deneskumar, the rider of NO NONSENSE, in the presence of his Master, Trainer L Moy.

After further viewing the official patrol films of this event and also the extensive use of the inside barrier cameras, the Stewards adjourned this inquiry to a date to be fixed to allow the owner of this horse to attend the inquiry.

No prohibited substances were detected.

After reviewing the video and hearing further evidence from Jockey Y Aify, the rider of SUPREME SASSO and Trainer C Robert, the trainer of SUPREME SASSO, the Inquiry was adjourned till tomorrow, Sunday, 17th July 2016.

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**INQUIRY INTO THE RIDING AND HANDLING OF “RIGHT TIMING”
RIDDEN BY APP AM AIZAT IN RACE 3 (R864) ENRICH STAKES A –
1100M(str) – BEST BET STAKES [SET-WEIGHTS] - PERAK JULY MEETING
2016, SATURDAY, 9th JULY 2016**

The Stewards today continued an inquiry into the above matter and took further evidence from App AM Aizat, the rider of RIGHT TIMING, in the presence of his Master, Trainer Ms Robyn Jensen and Trainer Evert Van Breukelen, the trainer of RIGHT TIMING.

After reviewing the video and hearing further evidence, the Stewards noted that it was App AM Aizat’s first ride on the horse and that the horse had hung in at several stages of the race. App AM Aizat was never able to get clear running until the final stages of the race. Their explanations were noted.

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**RACE 6 (R867) CLASS 5 – 1400M (sc) DENTENTURIUS HANDICAP
PERAK JULY MEETING 2016, SATURDAY, 9th JULY 2016**

After reviewing the video, the Stewards questioned Jockey J Low, the rider of TEEN ANGEL in the above race. He explained that the horse was a usual slow-beginner but had began well and settled back in the field. From the 600M, he commenced to ride forward but in the straight, using his whip in his left hand, this mare responded fairly to his riding and finished the race off well. Stewards noted his explanations.

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**RACE 9 (R870) PREMIUM 3&4 YO – 1200M (sc) MISS NATHAN STAKES
PERAK JULY MEETING 2016, SATURDAY, 9th JULY 2016**

The Stewards concluded an inquiry into EXPLOSIVE FORCE dislodging its rider App KC Tham at the 600M.

App KC Tham explained that EXPLOSIVE FORCE was racing greenly and had been racing tight inside of RUFFLE THE RUFFIAN (App AM Aizat), which was also racing greenly and when the horse was brushed, EXPLOSIVE FORCE became unbalanced and dislodged App KC Tham. It was also established that EYEOFTHETIGER (WK Yan) had got onto the heels of EXPLOSIVE FORCE and had to be checked. As such, no further action was taken.
