**RACE 1 (R1430) CLASS 5 – 1200m(sc) - BIG CHIEF 1985 HANDICAP**

EMPIRE BAY (KT Cheng) which stood and lost considerable ground, will be required to pass one starting stall test before being declared to race again.

At the start, CIZEN BROTHER (S Sandana) was tightened for room when MAYWEATHER (HS Gill) jumped awkwardly inwards and SING ENERGY (App S Saddam) jumped awkwardly outwards.

MAL'S DAD (C Goon) was slow into stride and showed no early pace, despite being urged.

Post-race veterinary examinations of ENLIGHTEN KNIGHT (M Yusri) revealed no obvious abnormality and MAL'S DAD returned having cast both its fore plates.

The Stewards questioned Jockey J De Souza as to the apparent poor performance of BLACK COFFEE and he stated that from a wide barrier, he raced wide throughout the race and the horse did not act in the going, failed to respond to his riding from the 500M and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination of BLACK COFFEE revealed that the gelding returned with respiratory distress and as such, will be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) before being declared to race again.

## **RACE 2 (R1431) CLASS 5 –1200m(sc) – DEER HUNTER 1986 HANDICAP**

GHOST WITH LUCK, a course scratching as it was lame off fore, will be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) before being declared to race again.

STAR BEAUTY which was up 16kgs in body weight since its last run, was checked by the Club Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and was passed fit to start.

The Stewards acceded to a request from Trainer K Coetzee to remove the use of pacifier on BALBOA (R Woodworth) due to the adverse track condition.

LEE'S SURPRISE (S Salee) jumped away awkwardly.

ASTROHEAT (App WK Lee) was slow into stride.

TAVAN BOGD (F Yap) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of SEA MASTER (J De Souza) at the 900M.

Racing to the 700M, ASTROHEAT had to be steadied to avoid the heels of LUCKY MONEY (App CT Lee) and continued to race wide until entering the straight. Shortly after this incident, SEA MASTER laid out, taking LUCKY MONEY wider and SEA MASTER continued to race wide until entering the straight.

Racing to the 100M, JERAM GLORY (App S Saddam) laid out and as a consequence, App S Saddam was obliged to stop and straighten his mount.

App KC Wong, the rider of RUMPELSTILTSKIN reported that his mount was not striding out freely. A post-race veterinary examination of RUMPELSTILTSKIN revealed no obvious abnormality.

Post-race veterinary examinations of BALBOA, BUKIT BINTANG (J Low) and TAVAN BOGD revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that CALLMESOON (HK Cheng) returned lame near fore and as such, will be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) before being declared to race again.

### **RACE 3 (R1432) CLASS 5 – 1200m(sc) HE’S DAWAN 1987 HANDICAP**

RACING MAN, a course scratching as it had sustained a cut to its mouth, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

DON’T FORGET THIS (HS Gill) proved difficult to be loaded. Trainer PK Leong was informed that a warning was placed on the gelding and he was advised to improve its barrier manners, failing which action may be taken.

DON’T FORGET THIS shifted out on jumping away, taking CHINESE STREET (App SU Lim) onto THRUST (M Yusri), resulting in THRUST losing its position.

CASPER (AM Aizat) raced wide from the 700M until entering the straight.

Jockey M Yusri, the rider of THRUST and Jockey S Sandana, the rider of AMPED both reported that their mounts were not striding out freely. Post-race veterinary examinations of THRUST, AMPED and CONQUISTADOR (F Yap) revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Stewards questioned Trainer K Coetzee, the Trainer of FLUTZ as to that gelding’s improved performance today. Trainer K Coetzee stated that FLUTZ did not act in the heavy track in Penang on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2016 on a heavy track and it is better-suited today on a soft going. His explanation was noted.

### **RACE 4 (R1433) CLASS 4 – 1100m(str) MITAVITE SUSTAINA HANDICAP**

Emergency acceptors WASHINGTON BAY and TILSWORTH FREDDIE were withdrawn due to a capacity field.

PROBABLY, which was down 15kgs in body weight since its last run, was checked by the Club Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and was passed fit to start.

Racing from the 400M until about the 250M, ONLY YOU (App KC Wong) was inconvenienced by OUR FRIENDLY DIVA (L Sofhan) which was laying out.

AVANTI (App S Saddam) was held up for a clear run on the heels of PROBABLY (R Woodworth) from the 150M to the 100M.

App SU Lim, the rider of CHINO DIABLO reported that his mount was not striding out freely.

PRETTY DOG (App T Krisna) which raced poorly, will be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) before being declared to race again.

Post-race veterinary examinations of CHINO DIABLO and NOTHING TO LOSE (J Low) revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that AVANTI, MAZANDARAN (AM Aizat), HERE COMES THUNDER (S Sandana) and WARN YOU MAN (F Yap) all returned having cast their off fore plate.

The Stewards questioned Trainer S Cook, the Trainer of ONLY YOU as to that gelding's improved performance today. Trainer S Cook stated that ONLY YOU did not act in the heavy track in Penang on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2016 and it is better-suited today on a soft going. His explanation was noted.

#### **RACE 5 (R1434) CLASS 4 –1100m (str) ENA HANDICAP**

DANE'S ANATOMY, a course scratching as it had sustained a bruised near hind cannon, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

GHOST AFFAIR, a course scratching as it was lame near fore, will be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) before being declared to race again.

SERPICO which was up 26kgs in body weight since its last run, was checked by the Club Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and was passed fit to start.

AUGUSTA (App T Krisna) jumped away awkwardly, got its head up and lost ground.

Racing to the 900M, CIZEN GIFT (R Woodworth) shifted in slightly, resulting in WAR LORD (App M Sathiaa) bumping LUCK ALOT (App S Saddam) which was forced in and had to be checked to avoid the heels of BEYOND WEALTH (App KC Wong) which was taken out slightly when BLACK RAIN (F Yap) shifted out onto MOGAN'S PET (App CT Lee). The Stewards were unable to attribute blame to any rider in these incidents.

Jockey R Woodworth, the rider of CIZEN GIFT reported that his mount was not striding out freely. A post-race veterinary examination of CIZEN GIFT revealed ...no obvious abnormality.

Jockey SS Vanan, the rider of RUBY DANE reported that he dropped his inside rein at the final 50M.

Post-race veterinary examinations of BEYOND WEALTH and CIZEN GIFT revealed no obvious abnormality.

Post-race veterinary examinations of LUCK ALOT revealed that the gelding had returned with respiratory distress and MR DREYFUSS (AM Aizat) returned with sinus infection. LUCK ALOT will be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) and MR DREYFUSS will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that MOGAN'S PET, JOYFUL (KT Cheng) and BERCHAM (WK Yan) returned having cast their off hind, off fore and near fore plate respectively.

#### **RACE 6 (R1435) CLASS 5 – 1200m(sc) - ELCARIM 1988 HANDICAP**

Trainer Evert Van Breukelen was fined RM250/- for negligence under MRA Rule 152(5)(a) for failing to seek the Stewards' permission to remove the ear muff and blinkers on CAMRY (Y Aify) within the stipulated time.

Acting on a veterinary report that SMALL TIGER (J Low) was lame off hind, the Stewards ordered its withdrawal at 4.19pm. SMALL TIGER will be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) before being declared to race again.

PRINCE ISLANDER (C Goon) was slow to begin.

Jockey HS Gill, the rider of KING OF SEAL lost his near side iron on jumping away and was inconvenienced in the first 50M. He also reported that his mount was not striding out freely. A post-race veterinary examination of KING OF SEAL revealed no obvious abnormality.

The saddle on CAMRY slipped backwards during the running.

POT BLACK (J Chuah) dipped at about the 1000M.

Post-race veterinary examinations of LAZAROO (S Sandana), POT BLACK and HOFBURG PALACE (J De Souza) all revealed no obvious abnormality.

Jockey R Woodworth, the rider of LUCK TREASURE reported that over the final 100M, he suffered a hand cramp and was unable to ride in his normal manner. The Stewards confirmed his condition with the Club Medical Officer who certified him fit to fulfil the remainder of his riding engagements today.

The Stewards questioned Trainer R Lines as to the poor performance of HOFBURG PALACE today. He stated that the jockey carried out his instructions to be handy and that the horse had failed to perform in Penang on a heavy going on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2016. Jockey J De Souza, the rider of HOFBURG PALACE stated that the gelding settled well in the pace and had a good run throughout and failed to respond to his riding from the 500M.

The Stewards also questioned Trainer R Lines regarding the improved performance of BULL AND BEAR (SS Vanan). He stated that the gelding failed to handle the heavy going in Penang on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2016 and that he thought BULL AND BEAR was better-suited to today's soft going and the gelding was racing in a weaker field. Trainer R Lines felt that the gelding had a good run today and this is the only explanation he could offer for the improved performance. His explanation was noted.

#### **RACE 7 (R1436) CLASS 5 – 1200m (sc) – VICTORY TREADMILL STAKES**

ONE MORE ACHIEVER which was up 18kgs in body weight since its last run, was checked by the Club Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and was passed fit to start.

Steady rain fell prior and during the running of this race.

GOLD DANCER (App CT Lee) was slow to begin.

GREAT GERONIMO (App KC Wong) which was racing ungenerously, dipped at about the 900M and had to be steadied to avoid the heels of THE THINKER (S Sandana) at about the 700M.

All riders returned an average 0.5kg over.

Post-race veterinary examinations of DUE HOME (J Low) and KAISER (C Goon) revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Stewards questioned Trainer E Seet, the Trainer of DAWN PROSPECT as to that gelding's improved performance today. Trainer E Seet stated that DAWN PROSPECT did not act in the heavy track in Penang on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2016 and it is better-suited today on a soft going. Her explanation was noted.

#### **RACE 8 (R1437) CLASS 5 - 1200m (sc) - COOL PERFORMER HANDICAP**

FOREVER BEST which was up 17kgs in body weight since its last run, was checked by the Club Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and was passed fit to start.

DARK EXPRESS (KT Cheng) and GOOD VIBRATIONS (J De Souza) both jumped away awkwardly.

App KC Wong, the rider of KUANTAN HILL and Jockey KT Cheng, the rider of DARK EXPRESS both reported that their mounts were not striding out freely.

Post-race veterinary examinations of KUANTAN HILL (App KC Wong), DARK EXPRESS and VINTAGE VERDOT (App CT Lee) revealed no obvious abnormality.

Racing to the 50M, CLASSIC KING (CK Tan) drifted out and as a result, J Low, the rider of ALIEN accidentally struck the whip off Jockey CK Tan.

FOREVER BEST (HS Gill) and THE PROFESSIONAL (R Woodworth) which both raced poorly, will each be required to pass a test (1000M & vet) before being declared to race again.

Prior to the 'All Clear' being given, an objection was lodged by Jockey CK Tan, the rider of CLASSIC KING placed 2<sup>nd</sup> against ALIEN (J Low) being declared the winner on grounds of alleged interference at the final 100M. After considering all the evidence, the Racing Stewards were of the opinion that the alleged interference had not affected the result of the race. The objection was overruled and the results stood.

## **GENERAL REPORT**

**WITHDRAWAL OF AN APPEAL FROM JOCKEY Y AIFY AGAINST THE 3 MONTHS SUSPENSION IMPOSED BY THE STIPENDIARY STEWARDS UNDER MRA RULE 44(10) IN CONNECTION WITH HIS RIDING & HANDLING OF “SUPREME SASSO” IN RACE 2(R863), CLASS 5 – 1100M(str) SOVEREIGN HANDICAP, SATURDAY, 9<sup>th</sup> JULY 2016, PERAK JULY MEETING 2016.**

On 27<sup>th</sup> October 2016, the Perak Turf Club Racing Stewards acceded to Jockey Y Aify’s application to withdraw his appeal on the above matter. Jockey Y Aify’s license to ride in races was reinstated under MRA Rule 48(8)(b) with effect from the Selangor Turf Club October meeting 2016 on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> October 2016 and he was refunded RM1,250/- of his deposit.
