RACE 1 (R1455) CLASS 5 - 1400m(lc) – GUNUNG HIJAU HANDICAP

SING ENERGY (HS Gill) and SHARP KNIGHT (App Z Khairil) were both slow to begin.

SING ENERGY had to be steadied racing to the 300M when CLAIM (Y Aify) rolled out and at the same time, SING ENERGY was laying in.

SING ENERGY had to be steadied to avoid the heels of MARATHON LAD (HK Cheng) racing to the 250M and shifted in to obtain a clear run.

Jockey KT Cheng, the rider of GOLD COAST CAPTAIN, reported that his saddle slipped backwards during running. A post-race veterinary examination of GOLD COAST CAPTAIN revealed no obvious abnormality.

A post-race veterinary examination of GLORY BETTING revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that WILL BE BETTER returned having cast its off fore plate.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that PRINCE ISLANDER bled and will be barred from racing for a period of three (3) months under MRA Rule 92(3) and thereafter will be required to pass a bleeder's test before being declared to race again.

At the conclusion of an inquiry today, Jockey M Ganeesh, the rider of PRINCE ISLANDER, pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under MRA Rule 44(9)(a)(ii) in that racing to the 1200M in this race, he shifted inwards when insufficiently clear of RACING MAN (App S Saddam) resulting in RACING MAN being taken in, causing

GLORY BETTING (S Sandana) to check and lose its position. RACING MAN continued to be taken in resulting inwards CLAIM having to be checked.

In assessing the penalty, the Stewards took into account Jockey M Ganeesh's guilty plea and his riding records. Jockey M Ganeesh was suspended from riding in races for a period of two (2) Malaysian race days. Acting on the provisions of MRA Rule 48(5), the Stewards deferred the commencement of Jockey M Ganeesh's suspension to take effect from Monday, 28 November 2016 and to expire on Saturday, 10 December 2016, both dates inclusive. He was advised of his Right of Appeal (1:35pm).

DEPUTY LAW (App S Saddam) was leaning on the inside of the barrier and jumped away awkwardly.

A post-race veterinary examination of DEPUTY LAW revealed that it was lame off fore and as such will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

Post-race veterinary examinations of BALBOA (HS Gill), LOVE EXCEL (HK Cheng), PHILIP (J De Souza), CAMRY (Y Aify) and ZENIDIN (S Sandana) revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 3 (R1457) CLASS 5 – 1400m(lc) - GUNUNG BEREMBUN HANDICAP

KUANTAN HILL (App M Sathiaa), a course scratching as it had a sore back, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

ENLIGHTEN KNIGHT (CK Tan), a course scratching as it had sustained a bruised off fore tendon, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

Shortly after the start, LIGHTNING ROD (App S Saddam), MAYWEATHER (HS Gill) and JACKWIN (App SU Lim) brushed.

Post-race veterinary examinations of JACKWIN and LIGHTNING ROD revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 4 (R1458) CLASS 4 - 1200m(lc) – GUNUNG BATU PUTIH HANDICAP

Acting on a report from the Starter that BANKERS CALL (J De Souza) was difficult to be loaded, the Stewards ordered the withdrawal of the gelding at 2:21pm. BANKERS CALL will be required to pass a test (1 starting stall) before being declared to race again.

WARN YOU MAN (F Yap) jumped away awkwardly and was tightened shortly after the start when AGUERO (S Sandana) shifted in and lost its position.

MESSI (CK Tan) was slow into stride.

D’GREAT VICTORY (J Low) dipped racing to the 1000M and shortly after, had to be steadied to avoid the heels of TAGORE (HS Gill) which commenced to over-race and shifted ground outwards. TAGORE continued to race ungenerously and shifted out resulting in D’GREAT VICTORY having to be checked.

NOTHING TO LOSE (KT Cheng) and MESSI both raced wide from the 700M until entering the straight.

At about the 300M, D’GREAT VICTORY rolled out and bumped AGUERO which brushed TAGORE which rolled in.

From about the 200M, D’GREAT VICTORY rolled out and brushed AGUERO resulting in both horses becoming unbalanced for some distance.

Post-race veterinary examinations D’GREAT VICTORY, TAGORE and WARN YOU MAN revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 5 (R1459) CLASS 4 – 1200m(lc) – GUNUNG GAYONG HANDICAP

AUDACIOUS, a course scratching as it had sustained a cut to its off hind cannon, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

RUFFLE THE RUFFIAN (App Z Khairil) jumped away awkwardly. During the running of the race at about the 200M, the saddle on RUFFLE THE RUFFIAN slipped backwards severely, placing the rider at a disadvantage and App Z Khairil had to ease his mount out of the race at approximately the 50M.

At about the 50M, STREET TEASE (S Sandana) had to be steadied to avoid RUFFLE THE RUFFIAN when RUFFLE THE RUFFIAN was being eased out of the race.

WASHINGTON BAY (HS Gill) which raced poorly, will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

A post-race veterinary examination of RUFFLE THE RUFFIAN revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that THE DUKE returned having cast its near fore plate.

RACE 6 (R1460) CLASS 5 – 1000m(sc) – GUNUNG BILAH HANDICAP

JOHNNY'S CAFE a course scratching as it had colic, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

HOLLYWOOD BOY (M Yusri) was slow to begin and showed no early pace.

JET ACE (App S Saddam) jumped away awkwardly.

Racing to the 800M, DARK EXPRESS (App KC Wong) over-raced and became unbalanced for a short distance.

RANGITAIKI (HK Cheng) got its head up on several occasions and lost ground at the 700M.

LANDING NORTH (J Low) raced wide from the 700M until entering the straight.

Passing the 200M, ONE MORE ACHIEVER (M Ganeesh) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of LANDING NORTH which laid in under pressure.

Post-race veterinary examinations JET ACE, ONE MORE ACHIEVER and EXCELLENT GOAL (S Thai Yang) and HOLLYWOOD BOY revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that MONEY NOT ENOUGH (App CT Lee) returned having cast its off hind plate.

A post-race veterinary examination of THUNDER KING revealed that the gelding returned broken-winded and as such will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

RACE 7 (R1461) CLASS 5 – 1000m(sc) – PUNCAK HANDICAP

CHARLIE CAME ALONG which was down 15kgs in body weight since its last run, was checked by the Club Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and was passed fit to start.

FLUTZ, a course scratching as it had sustained a stone-bruised off fore, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

ARCHAEOLOGY, a course scratching as it had corneal ulcer on its right eye, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

ZAC GALLANT, a course scratching as it had sustained a stone-bruised off fore foot, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

Shortly after the start, WOW (R Woodworth) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of I'M KOOL (M Leong) which shifted in.

DRAGON WALK (J Low) raced wide from the 700M until entering the straight.

I'M KOOL had to be steadied racing to the 250M to avoid the heels of COSTNER (J Chuah) and shifted out to obtain a clear run.

Jockey J Low, the rider of DRAGON WALK, reported that his horse did not handle the going.

Post-race veterinary examinations of CABRERA (F Yap) and DON'T FORGET THIS (KT Cheng) revealed no obvious abnormality.

A post-race veterinary examination of SILVER AND GOLD (App SU Lim) revealed that it was lame near fore and as such will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

The Club Veterinary Surgeon reported that MR JAI bled and will be barred from racing for a period of three (3) months under MRA Rule 92(3) and thereafter will be required to pass a bleeder's test before being declared to race again.

RACE 8 (R1462) CLASS 5 – 1800m(sc) – GUNUNG SEPUTEJ HANDICAP

FASTNET STAR (App CT Lee) and D'GREAT HAWK (J Low) were both slow to begin.

The saddle on DUEL OF HONOUR (R Woodworth) slipped to the off side during running. A post-race veterinary examination of DUEL OF HONOUR revealed no obvious abnormality.

Post-race veterinary examinations of IWA ANTILIA (KT Cheng), D'GREAT HAWK (J Low) and TIME TO SHINE (M Yusri) revealed no obvious abnormality.

At the conclusion of an inquiry, App SU Lim, the rider of LUCK DRAGON, in the presence of his Acting Master, Trainer K Coetzee, was found guilty of a charge under MRA Rule 152(5)(a) for negligence in that he dropped his whip at about the 300M. He was fined the sum of RM1000/- and was advised of his Right of Appeal (4:45pm).

MATA MATA (S Sandana) had to be steadied off the heels of CARBON COPY (HS Gill) racing to the 1600M and shifted out abruptly and raced wide for a short distance.

PISCES JET (J De Souza) laid out under the whip over the concluding stages.

A post-race veterinary examination of SUPER CROWN (SS Vanan) revealed that it was lame off fore and as such will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

Post-race veterinary examinations of NATURE IS NATURE (KT Cheng), MATA MATA and NANA (App Z Khairil) revealed no obvious abnormality.

The Stewards ordered the withdrawal of WONDERFUL SURPRISE (R Woodworth) at 2:45pm. An inquiry into the reasons relating to the withdrawal of the gelding was adjourned to a date to be fixed.

SUGAR BABY (CK Tan) was slow into stride.

Racing to the 1000M, WELLINGTON HAMMER (J Low) which was racing greenly, steadied when SUGAR BABY shifted in slightly and as a consequence, WELLINGTON HAMMER lost some ground.

Jockey J Low, the rider of WELLINGTON HAMMER, reported that his horse did not act in the going. A post-race veterinary examination of WELLINGTON HAMMER revealed no obvious abnormality. The gelding was impounded.

A post-race veterinary examination of MASTER OF SUCCESS (J De Souza) revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 11 (R1465) COSMO B – 1400m(sc) – GUNUNG KORBU STAKES [SET-WEIGHTS]

FIELD FORCE, a course scratching as it had sustained a bruised neck, will be required to pass a veterinary examination before being declared to race again.

Approaching the 800M, Jockey Y Aify, the rider of TEN SENSE WIN, had to readjust his foot into his off side stirrup iron.

Passing the 50M, App Z Khairil, the rider of CRAZY CLUB, had his whip accidentally knocked from his hand by App SU Lim, the rider of LUCK SUCCESS.

Post-race veterinary examinations of INTENTION (App KC Wong) and FORTUNIQUE (J Low) revealed no obvious abnormality. INTENTION which raced poorly, will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

The Stewards questioned Jockey S Sandana, the rider of RIGHT TIMING, and he explained that his instructions were to be midfield and that after he got a good jump, he was not satisfied with the horse's action. He further stated that the horse ran on fairly but was not striding out in the going. His explanation was noted. Jockey S Sandana reported after the race that his horse was not striding out freely. A post-race veterinary examination of RIGHT TIMING revealed that it was lame off fore and as such will be required to pass a test (1000M/vet) before being declared to race again.

**HEARING OF AN APPEAL OF APP KC THAM AGAINST THE SIX MONTHS
SUSPENSION AND RM20,000 FINE IMPOSED BY THE STIPENDIARY
STEWARDS UNDER MRA RULE 44(10) IN CONNECTION WITH THE
RUNNING & HANDLING OF “CLASSIC ARROW” IN RACE 5 (R538), CLASS 5
– 1400M(sc) – ONE THREE ONE HANDICAP, PERAK LATE APRIL MEETING
2016, 2nd DAY, SUNDAY, 24th APRIL 2016.**

The Perak Turf Club Racing Stewards heard the above appeal on Friday, 18th November 2016.

After hearing submissions from App KC Tham, his Master, Trainer Johnny BT Lim and the Acting Chief Stipendiary Steward, Mr. Philip Anderson and reviewing the video of the race, the Racing Stewards dismissed the appeal.

The suspension of six (6) months and fine of RM20,000/- imposed were confirmed. App KC Tham's suspension was backdated to start from Sunday, 6th November 2016 and to expire on Friday, 5th May 2017, both dates inclusive. His deposit was forfeited.

TUESDAY, 8 NOVEMBER 2016, SELANGOR TURF CLUB TRACK WORK

SUPER GOOD (F675) returned having bled, and in terms of MRA Rule 92(3), it will not be permitted to canter or gallop on the main training tracks of any racecourse for a period of 2 months, and be entered for a bleeder's test for a period of 3 months, and start in any race for a period of 3 months after such declaration, and then only after passing the bleeder's test.

**RACE 3 (R1403) CLASS 4 – 1300M (SHORT COURSE A), SATURDAY, 5
NOVEMBER 2016, SELANGOR TURF CLUB NOVEMBER MEETING 2016**

In assessing the penalty, the Stewards took into consideration App R Fakuaddin's mitigating factors, previous good riding record and his submissions on penalty. He was

suspended from riding in races for a period of one (1) month with effect from 6 November 2016 and to expire on 5 December 2016, both dates inclusive. He was advised of his Right of Appeal (5:10pm). It is noted that the Chief Stipendiary Steward excused himself during this inquiry.

App R Fakruddin (GAZOO) subsequently exercised his Right of Appeal and applied for a Stay of Sentence. The Stewards considered the application for a stay which was granted. The appeal hearing against the penalty of the suspension of one (1) month will be held at a date to be fixed.

RACE 9 (R1409) CLASS 5 – 1400M (LONG COURSE A), SATURDAY, 5 NOVEMBER 2016, SELANGOR TURF CLUB NOVEMBER MEETING 2016

App KC Tham (SKY WALKER) exercised his Right of Appeal and applied for a Stay of Sentence. The Stipendiary Stewards considered the application for a stay which was not granted. He was advised of his Right of Appeal.

RACE 10 (R1276) CLASS 5 – 1600M (LONG COURSE A), SUNDAY, 9 OCTOBER 2016, SELANGOR TURF CLUB OCTOBER MEETING 2016

Jockey C Goon (ROCK D’BOAT) who lodged an appeal against his suspension of two (2) Malaysian race days, applied to withdraw his appeal on 14 November 2016. After consideration, the Racing Stewards acceded to his application, and his deposit was forfeited. His suspension commenced on 19 November 2016 and to expire on 26 November 2016, both dates inclusive, to be served concurrently with his current suspension (14 November 2016 to 3 December 2016).

RACE 1 (R1401) CLASS 5 – 1400M (SHORT COURSE A), SATURDAY, 5 NOVEMBER 2016, SELANGOR TURF CLUB NOVEMBER MEETING 2016

The Stewards, on 18 November 2016 at the Selangor Turf Club, concluded an inquiry into an incident at the 1000M mark where App AK Lim, the rider of SHIRLEY BEAUTY, was dislodged from his horse. The Stewards took extensive evidence from App AK Lim, in the presence of his Master, Trainer WC Lim who is also the Trainer of SHIRLEY BEAUTY, Jockey J De Souza and Trainer R Lines, the rider and Trainer of HAPPY AMIGO respectively.

After viewing the official patrol films of this event and considering the evidence tendered, the Stewards acting on their own observations, gave Jockey J De Souza “benefit of the doubt” as in their opinion, he was not 100 percent to be blamed for this incident.

The Stewards were of the opinion that leading up to this incident, HAPPY AMIGO did have a tendency to lay outwards despite the efforts of its rider and this was confirmed by viewing the gelding’s previous race start as tendered in evidence and approaching the

1000M, the gelding shifted out abruptly over the heels of DAWN OF THE WORLD (App SU Lim) which resulted in SHIRLEY BEAUTY which was racing wide, to clip the heels of HAPPY AMIGO and blundered resulting in App AK Lim being dislodged.

The Stewards were mindful that this shift outwards was quick and Jockey J De Souza made some efforts to straighten the gelding, however, were of the opinion that a greater effort could have been made. The Stewards took no action against Jockey J De Souza given the horse's previous record and reminded him of what is expected by the Stewards. The Stewards noted their comments for future reference.
